## Verification of Skills and Knowledge for Providing Clinical Supervision

Partners in Recovery certifies that clinical supervision provided at the Direct Care Sites is provided by an individual who:

A. Has the skills and knowledge to provide services in the following areas:

B. Is one of the following:

- A behavioral health professional, or
- A behavioral health technician with a combination of full-time behavioral health work experience and post high school education in a field related to behavioral health totaling at least six years.

C. Partners in Recovery certifies that a behavioral health technician has skills and knowledge in providing clinical supervision that are verified:

1. Before the behavioral health technician provides clinical supervision;
2. By a behavioral health professional who provides clinical supervision; and
3. Through visual observation of the behavioral health technician interacting with another individual, such as through role playing exercises;

- Verification that supervisee understands the role and responsibility of a clinical supervisor
- Verification that the supervisee has the necessary skill sets to provide oversight and guidance to a supervisee who diagnoses, creates treatment plans, and treats clients
- The supervisee understands the concepts of supervision methods and techniques.

3. Reviewing and discussing other topics that enhance the skills and knowledge of staff members; and
4. For a behavioral health technician providing a client with an assessment or treatment plan, determining whether an assessment or treatment plan is complete and accurate and meets the client's treatment needs.
